#### GROUP STUDY EXCHANGE

#### Need Experienced Rotarians to lead Group Study Exchange team to Mexico Dist. 4170 next spring:

The Group Study Exchange program has provided grants for countless teams of men and women in the early stages of their business and professional careers to travel abroad and share vocational information with the representatives of their respective professions in another country. While visiting abroad, GSE team members follow a carefully planned itinerary, including visits to government and cultural institutions, schools, religious and historic sites and other points of interest. In addition, each member spends at least 5 days studying and observing the practice of his or her profession in the host district.

The Foundation grant funds round-trip air transportation for each team member. Rotarians provide lodging in their homes, meals, and group travel, allowing the opportunity for participants to become acquainted with the customs and culture of the people in their host district. Team Members must be between the ages of 25 - 40 and employed full-time, with a minimum of two-years experience, in a recognized business or profession. After their study abroad, participants are expected to speak about their experiences at Rotary meetings and other civic functions.

If you are interested in being the Team Leader please complete the Team Leader Application available at [www.rotary6060.org/view/37](http://www.rotary6060.org/view/37). The ideal Team Leader is an active Rotarian who loves to travel, can mold an effective GSE team, and can be away from work and home for four weeks, April 23 – May21, 2011. **Deadline for submitting an application is September 10.** Interested?
