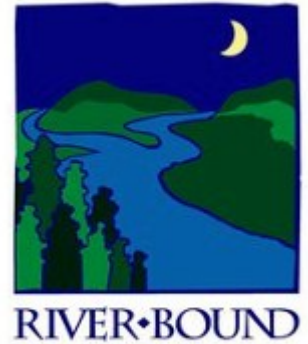

THE LIFE & TIMES OF PETE BROEDER

Pete is a creative kind of guy. In his real life, during the daylight hours, he is a cartoonist and is involved in the advertising industry. When the sun goes down, however, another Pete emerges....not exactly a rock star but well, is there such a thing as a banjo star?

The band is called "RiverBound". The members met at a music ensemble class at The Folk School in Maplewood. This is a music school that teaches lessons for traditional music on acoustic instruments from beginners to advanced players. The band plays traditional Bluegrass music. The band was named "RiverBound" because all members are from this area and we are near the confluence of the mighty rivers. They also all enjoy float trips and the name "Soggy Bottom Boys" was already taken. After they decided on a name Pete drew up a logo and they sell "RiverBound" shirts at their shows.



For the past three or four years the band members had been playing in pick-up jam sessions learning how to play as a group. Last year they started to play as a band. There are six members and you can recognize Pete, he is the only banjo player and also one of the four members doing vocals. Pete started playing the banjo seven years ago. He only other musical experience was singing tenor in the high school choir. Others in the band have been playing various instruments for many years.

This is how "RiverBound" was described in the paper previewing one of the shows: "In the tradition of Bill Monroe, Jimmy Martin and Flatt and Scruggs, RiverBound features a mix of traditional fiddle tunes and bluegrass songs. Enjoy their bass, banjo, guitar, fiddle and mandolin, as they have a lot of fun putting their stamp on this distinctive American folk music."

Pete's favorite song to sing is "A Hundred Years From Now".

They have been playing at "Six Row Brewing Company" and rumor has it that Peter Bogetto and Dave Jones were so overcome by the music that they danced Jed Clampett style in front of the stage at one recent show (drinking seems to have been involved).
